## Dear Senators:

We, the undersigned Attorneys General of our States, write to urge the Senate to expeditiously consider and confirm the nomination of David Chipman as Director of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives (ATF). Mr. Chipman is an experienced law enforcement professional who will lead ATF with conviction and help protect communities across the country from gun violence.

As the chief law and law enforcement officers in our respective states and territories, many of us regularly work with ATF to combat violent criminals and gun trafficking in our communities. He has deep experience at that agency, and he is ready to work with law enforcement, the communities most heavily impacted by violence, and others to make our nation safer while upholding Americans' Second Amendment rights.
