## 7 SECTION 1. COMMITTEE

## 8 CONSIDERATION OF NOMINEES.

- The Rules of Procedure of the Judiciary Committee of
- the Senate is amended by adding at the end the following:
- 11 "IX."
- "(a) In considering a nomination, the committee
- shall conduct an investigation or review of the nominee's
- experience, qualifications, and suitability, to serve in the
- position to which he or she has been nominated. To aid in
- such investigation or review, each nominee may be
- 17 required to submit a sworn detailed statement including
- biographical, financial, policy, and other information
- 19 (including tax returns of the nominee) which the
- 20 committee may request. Subject to subparagraph (b), the
- committee may specify which items are to be received on
- 22 a confidential basis."
- 23 "(b) As part of an investigation or review with respect
- to a cabinet-level nominee under subparagraph (a), the
- committee shall require that the nominee provide the
- committee with the individual tax returns of the nominee
- 27 for the 3 years preceding the nomination. Such tax
- returns shall be considered as confidential, except that the
- 29 Chairman and Ranking Member may jointly issue a
- 30 public statement or report regarding any matters in the
- individual tax returns that reflect on the nominee's fitness

1	for the office to which he or she was nominated.".
