4 (a) **REQUIREMENT.**—Beginning not later than 90
5 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-
6 retary of Homeland Security shall ensure that all incoming
7 vehicles and cargo crossing the international border be-

1 tween the United States and Mexico at any port of entry
2 are screened by a nonintrusive inspection system.

3 (b) EFFECT OF NONCOMPLIANCE.—During any pe-
4 riod in which the Secretary is not in full compliance with
5 the screening requirement described in subsection (a), the
6 Secretary may not issue any immigrant visas to individ-
7 uals under section 203(b)(5) of the Immigration and Na-
8 tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(b)(5)).
