FIRST SUPERSEDING INDICTMENT

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

COUNT ONE

Beginning at a time unknown to the grand jury, but from at least in or about June of 2006, and continuing until on or about October 8, 2008, in the Western District of Tennessee, the defendants,

did unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally conspire, combine, confederate and agree with each other, and with other persons both known and unknown to the Grand Jury, to possess with the intent to distribute a mixture and substance containing at least five kilograms of cocaine, a controlled substance as classified by Title 21, United States Code, Section 812,

as a Schedule II controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.

COUNT TWO

Beginning at a time unknown to the grand jury, but from at least in or about June of 2006, and continuing until on or about October 8, 2008, in the Western District of Tennessee, the defendants,

did unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally conspire, combine, confederate and agree with each other, and with other persons both known and unknown to the Grand Jury, to possess with the intent to distribute a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of marijuana, a controlled substance as classified by Title 21, United States Code, Section 812, as a Schedule I controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.

COUNT THREE

On or about August 23, 2006, in the Western District of Tennessee, the defendants,



each aided and abetted by the other, and aiding and abetting other persons known and unknown to the Grand Jury, did knowingly and willfully conduct a financial transaction affecting interstate commerce, to wit, the transfer and delivery of \$41,515 in United States currency to Jesus Vara, which involved the proceeds of specified unlawful activities, that is, distributing controlled substances in violation of 21 U.S.C. § 841, knowing that the funds involved in the financial transaction represented the proceeds of some form of unlawful activity, and with the intent to promote the carrying on of specified unlawful activities, that is, distributing controlled substances in violation of 21 U.S.C. § 841, all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1956(a)(1) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.
