6        On page 64, after line 23, insert the following:

1           (3) in subsection (f), by adding at the end the  
2 following:

3           “(5) SPAM.—The term ‘spam’ means material  
4 that is unsolicited, unauthorized, or malicious and is  
5 specifically directed at a provider or user of an inter-  
6 active computer service, including material that vio-  
7 lates the CAN-SPAM Act of 2003 (Public Law 108–  
8 187; 117 Stat. 2699), an amendment made by that  
9 Act, or a regulation issued or rule promulgated  
10 under that Act.”.
