Dear Senators Durbin and Graham:

We write to convey our strong support for the nomination of Sharad Desai to the United States District Court for the District of Arizona.

We are lawyers who have known Sharad professionally for many years. Some of us were colleagues at the same law firm (Osborn Maledon), and others served as co-counsel or opposing counsel in litigation. Coming from these very different perspectives, we share a common view: Sharad Desai will be an excellent addition to the District of Arizona bench.

In our dealings with Sharad, he has displayed a keen intellect, refined litigation skills and instincts, humility and common sense.
