2 **SEC. 110. REPORT ON RECIDIVISM.**

3 (a) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term “covered
4 individual” means an individual—

5 (1) whose sentence is reduced under this Act,
6 or an amendment made by this Act; and

7 (2) who, after the date on which the individual
8 is released from the custody of the Bureau of Pris-
9 ons, is charged with or convicted of a criminal of-
10 fense.

1 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date
2 of enactment of this Act, and every 90 days thereafter,
3 the United States Sentencing Commission shall, in coordi-
4 nation with the Attorney General and the Comptroller of
5 the United States, submit to the appropriate committees
6 of Congress a report that contains information pertaining
7 to covered individuals, including—

8 (1) the name, date of birth, and Bureau of
9 Prisons Register Number of the covered individual;

10 (2) the nature of the offense committed by the
11 by the covered individual, including the name of the
12 offense and corresponding citation to Federal or
13 State law;

14 (3) the jurisdiction in which the offense was
15 committed;

16 (4) the status of any Federal or State pro-
17 ceeding arising out of the offense; and

18 (5) any other information related to the offense
19 or subsequent criminal proceeding related thereto
20 that the United States Sentencing Commission de-
21 termines is relevant.
