Please allow me share with you what this means Act means to me. I lost my 16 year old, amazing, intelligent, outgoing, gorgeous daughter to fentanyl only 9 months ago. She had just finished her 10th grade year with straight A's, got a job working at Sonic the day she turned 16 on April 17, 2024. We bought her first car on May 20th, and she was so excited to get her license in mid May. Exactly 1 month and 1 week after her 16th birthday, she was poisoned to death. A 'friend' she knew from high school (who graduated on 05/17/2024), brought her death sentence to her at work on May 24, 2024. I picked her up at the end of her shift. She grabbed some food in the kitchen when we got home and then was on facetime with her boyfriend. An hour and a half later, I would walk into her room to find her slumped over her vanity. I first thought maybe she fell asleep, being so tired after her Friday night work shift. I quickly realized she wasn't breathing, yelled for my husband to call 911, as I started CPR on her. Fire & Paramedics arrived almost instantly, because we live 1 mile from a fire hall. They worked on her for an hour, trying everything to bring her back, but she was gone.

We need this Act to pass, without amendments to it. Please help us fight for our children, and the lives of others that can still be saved.
