2 **SEC. 110. INCREASED CIVIL PENALTY FOR CERTAIN OF-**  
3 **FENSES BY OPIOID MANUFACTURERS.**

4 Section 402(c)(1)(B) of the Controlled Substances  
5 Act (21 U.S.C. 842(c)(1)(B)) is amended by striking  
6 “shall not exceed \$10,000.” and inserting the following:

7 “shall not exceed—

8 “(i) except as provided in clause (ii), \$10,000;

9 and

10 “(ii) if the violation is committed by a manufac-  
11 turer of opioids and relates to the reporting of sus-

1        picious orders for opioids or failing to maintain ef-  
2        fective controls against diversion of opioids,  
3        \$100,000.”.
