This short note will speak to my dealings, interactions with Kato Crews. In my time as a Union Representative, I've sat across the table from many Corporate Management, Officers and legal counsel, many of which were closed minded and contentious in the handling of Employee matters. This was not the case with Mr. Crews

Over the past 10 years, I have worked though many weighted Employee issues with Mr. Crews and client sitting across the table, be it grievance meetings or arbitration hearings. Appearing on opposing sides of most issues, what I respected in Mr. Crews was his professionalism, his willingness to get to the bottom of an issue expeditiously and yet, not in a dismissive fashion. Employees received his full attention, their day in court, so to speak.
